

# Movin'March WoW Challenge Regional Class Competition - Competition Rules

## 1 ACCEPTANCE

- 1.1 **The Competition:** This Competition is run by Greater Wellington in accordance with these Competition Rules.
- 1.2 **Minors:** Persons under the age of 18 may participate in the Competition, provided that their class or group entry is registered by a teacher or staff member who is 18 years of age or older.
- 1.3 **Deemed acceptance:** When a teacher or staff member submits an Entry on behalf of a Participant, the submitting teacher or staff member accepts these Competition Rules on behalf of the Participant.

## 2 ENTRY PROCESS

- 2.1 **The Entry:** On or before the Entry Deadline, a Participant must:
  - 2.1.1 be represented by a teacher or staff member,
  - 2.1.2 ensure that the teacher or staff member registers on *Te Haerenga o ngā Tamariki* by providing their name, work email, the name of school, and the name of their classroom or group;
  - 2.1.3 record how the students in the classroom or group travelled to school for a single period of five (5) consecutive days (Monday-Friday) during the Competition Period, along with the total number of students in the class or group (the “**Data**”);
  - 2.1.4 submit the Data directly into *Te Haerenga o ngā Tamariki*; and
  - 2.1.5 provide the submitting teacher or staff member’s contact details;  
together (an **Entry**).
- 2.2 **Unaccepted Entry:** Entries submitted by email or in physical form (including wallcharts) will not be accepted.
- 2.3 **One entry only:** A Participant may only complete one Entry and may only win one Prize. If more than one Entry is submitted, the Data with the highest number of Walk or Wheel Trips will be treated as the Entry.
- 2.4 **Validity:** Only Entries that comply with this clause 2 and are not otherwise disqualified under clause 6.3 will be considered valid Entries.
- 2.5 **Verification:** We may verify the validity of the Winning Entry by:

2.5.1 confirming that the submitting teacher or staff member has a valid school email address,

2.5.2 confirming the Participant is a school or group in the Wellington region, and

2.5.3 asking the Participant to confirm that the Data is accurate to the best of their knowledge.

2.6 **Disqualified participants:** Disqualified Participants may not enter the Competition.

### 3 ENTRY DEADLINE

3.1 **Competition period:** The Competition will start on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2026, from 7am and will end on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2026 at 4pm (the “**Competition Period**”).

3.2 **Deadline:** All Entries must be submitted no later than 11:59pm on Monday the 20<sup>th</sup> of April 2026 (the “**Entry Deadline**”).

### 4 WINNING THE PRIZES

4.1 **The Winners:** The winners of the Competition will be selected by us as set out in these Competition Rules. Our determination is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

4.2 **The Draw:** On or before 5 pm on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2026, we will select six (6) Entries from all the valid Entries received by the Entry Deadline, as follows:

4.2.1 Three (3) Winning Entries will be the Participants with the highest percentage of Walk or Wheel Trips over the five (5) consecutive days (Monday-Friday). This percentage can be calculated using the formula:

$$\frac{\text{Total number of Walk or Wheel Trips}}{\text{Total number of students in class}} \times 100$$

each day

If any tie occurs in determining the top three (3) Participants, those tied Participants will be placed into a random draw to decide which of them will receive a Winning Entry.

4.2.2 Three (3) Winning Entries will be randomly drawn from the remaining valid Entries (including any tied Participants not selected under clause 4.2.1).

4.3 **Prizes:** The Participants that submitted a Winning Entry (each a **Winning Participant**) will each receive one of the Prizes.

- 4.4 **Exclusions:** The Prize does not include the cost of transportation. The Participants that receive a Prize may apply for the GW Student Transport Grant to cover transport costs for these trips, by completing an Application Form.
- 4.5 **Contact:** Using the email address provided with the Entry, we will contact each winning Participant to advise them of the win by the end of Friday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2026.
- 4.6 **Redraw:** If the Winning Participant does not respond by 5pm Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2026, will re-draw another Winning Entry.
- 4.7 **Delivery:** We will deliver the Prize as a voucher via email to the email address provided with the Entry.
- 4.8 **Confirmation of acceptance:**
  - 4.8.1 Prior to releasing the Prizes, we may request written confirmation of the acceptance of these Competition Rules from the Winning Participant.
  - 4.8.2 If written confirmation is not provided after such a request, the Prize will be forfeit and we will undertake a redraw.
- 4.9 **No transfer:** The Prize cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash.
- 4.10 **Unavailability:** If a Prize is unavailable for whatever reason, we may substitute a prize of an equivalent value.

## 5 PRIVACY

- 5.1 **Permission:** By submitting an Entry, you warrant to us that you have obtained all relevant permissions to enter this Competition. We will seek additional permission to share the Winning Participant, including class and/or school name (where applicable), in the Movin' March newsletter and/or our social media accounts.
- 5.2 **Purpose:** We may collect, store and use Personal Information provided with or within an Entry, or in connection with the Competition, as set out in (and in accordance with) our privacy statement: <https://www.gw.govt.nz/your-council/legal/privacy-statement/>.

## 6 GENERAL

- 6.1 **Associated terms:** You accept the Prize subject to any associated terms and conditions of use.

- 6.2 **Change:** We may suspend, amend, vary, extend or discontinue this Competition at any stage for any reason. Any such action will be notified by the MailChimp communication that goes out to all schools registered to receive this notification, and via an update on the competition page on the Kura Kete website <https://kurakete.gw.govt.nz/movinmarch-2026/class-challenge/>.
- 6.3 **Disqualification:** We may, in our sole discretion:
- 6.3.1 Disqualify any Entry that:
- 6.3.1.1 is not made in accordance with these Competition Rules;
  - 6.3.1.2 we consider to be unsolicited electronic communications and/or advertising;
  - 6.3.1.3 we reasonably consider breaches any law; or
  - 6.3.1.4 we reasonably consider is otherwise inappropriate;
- 6.3.2 Refuse to award the Prize to a Winning Participant where:
- 6.3.2.1 they have failed or refused to provide written confirmation under clause 4.8.1;
  - 6.3.2.2 we consider that they or any other person who has entered on their behalf has violated the Competition Rules in any way, gained unfair advantage in participating in the Competition or has won using fraudulent means.
- 6.4 **Governing Law:** These Competition Rules shall be governed by the laws of New Zealand and subject to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of New Zealand.
- 6.5 **Late or Invalid Entries:** Greater Wellington takes no responsibility for any inability to enter, complete, continue or conclude the Competition due to incorrect contact details, invalid, unclear or illegible Entries, equipment or technical malfunctions, busy lines, inadvertent disconnection, Force Majeure or otherwise.
- 6.6 **No Liability:** Subject to any applicable laws which cannot be excluded, Greater Wellington, its employees and agents will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury of any nature incurred or suffered by any person (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss or loss arising from negligence) arising directly or indirectly from or in connection with, this Competition or with winning, redeeming or benefiting from a Prize.
- 6.7 **No Waiver:** Failure by Greater Wellington to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

## 6.8 Third Party Sites:

6.8.1 In entering or participating in this Competition you may be using Third Party Sites.

6.8.2 Greater Wellington will comply with all its obligations to you in relation to the Third-Party Sites.

6.8.3 You are, however, solely responsible for ensuring that you are aware of and comply with your obligations in relation to these Third-Party Sites.

## 7 Definitions

**Application Form** means the student transport grant application form available here: <https://www.gw.govt.nz/assets/Documents/2023/02/student-transport-grant-application-form-2023-update.pdf>. Some conditions apply, see <https://www.gw.govt.nz/your-region/education/>.

**Competition:** The Greater Wellington Movin' March Regional Class Competition is designed to incentivise Participant's to travel to Walk or Wheel to school.

**Data** means the information required under clause 2.1.3 as part of an Entry.

**Disqualified Participant:** Any of the following people:

- (a) Any person living outside of the Wellington region.
- (b) Any individual or family group.

**Entry** has the meaning given in clause 2.1.

**Force Majeure** means events outside anyone's reasonable control, such as natural disasters, extreme weather, strikes, or other unexpected events that prevent something from happening as planned.

**Greater Wellington, we or our:** The Wellington Regional Council, a regional council in accordance the Local Government Act 2002, with its physical address at 100 Cuba Street, Te Aro, Wellington.

**Personal Information:** takes the meaning from the Privacy Act 2020.

**Participant:** A class or group in the Wellington region, who is not a Disqualified Participant, represented by a teacher or staff member who is 18 years of age or older. A class or group must be either:

- (a) A primary or intermediate class,
- (b) A special education class in a secondary school, or

- (c) Any other group whose primary purpose is education, with at least 15 students in years 0-8.

**Walk or Wheel Trips** means any trips to or from school made by a student using an active or shared mode of travel other than a private car, motorbike, van, or similar vehicle. Walk or Wheel Trips include, without limitation:

- (a) walking or walking school bus;
- (b) scootering, skating, skateboarding, rollerblading, or similar;
- (c) cycling, unicycling, travelling on a parent's bike, e-bike, or similar;
- (d) Park and Stride (walking part of the way);
- (e) public or shared transport such as bus, train, ferry, or school bus;
- (f) using a wheelchair or other mobility device or aid;
- (g) any other alternative modes (for example, horse, pogo stick, boat, or similar).

Walk or Wheel Trips do not include trips made by car (including electric vehicles), van, motorbike, carpooling, or entries that are unclear (such as "family" or "other").

**Winning Entry** means an entry selected in accordance with clause 4.2.

**Prizes:** We have a total of six (6) prizes available.

- The **first-place winner** of the draw under clause 4.2.1 will win:  
A Wheels Fun Day for the class, including a scooter and bike fix up (1 hour with Micro Scooters and Pedal Ready) and outdoor activities (wheels games and training) with Pedal Ready instructors for 2 hours. The class will also receive 1 x Micro Scooter (valued at \$220), Micro Scooter accessories (valued at approximately \$60), MyRide bike accessories (valued at approximately \$200) and use of Pedal Ready's bike or scooter fleet and ramps (total value, approx. \$500).
- The **second-place winner and third-place winner** of the draw under clause 4.2.1 will each win:  
A Wheels Fun Day for the class, including a scooter and bike fix up (1 hour with MyRide and Pedal Ready) and outdoor activities (wheels games and training) with Pedal Ready instructors for 2 hours. The class will also receive 1 x Micro Scooter (valued at \$220), Micro Scooter accessories (valued at approximately \$60), MyRide bike accessories (valued at approximately \$200) and use of Pedal Ready's bike or scooter fleet and ramps (total value, approx. \$500).

The **remaining three winners** will be randomly allocated one of the following available prizes:

- One (1) class trip to **Staglands Wildlife Reserve** (up to 30 children and 8 adults; valued at \$304),
- One (1) class trip to **Zealandia** (up to 30 children and 7 free adults; value approx. \$310);
- One (1) class trip to **Wētā Workshop** (up to 30 students, 2 free adults and up to 6 adult supervisors; value approx. \$780)

**Te Haerenga o ngā Tamariki** means the tool available at <https://tamariki.gw.govt.nz/> freely available for schools in the Wellington region.
